### **In case you missed June's meeting:**

### **Speaker for June meeting was Todd Coleman of Port of Vancouver**

#### Summary:

Todd spoke to the group about the focus of the Port and future plans for the land. The focus of the Port is primarily on marine and industrial development, and consists of mostly exports. The port handles 16% of all wheat exports. One of its imports is Subaru vehicles.

The economic development helps provide 17,000 jobs, 100 of which are directly with the Port of Vancouver. \$1.6 billion moves the port per year. We are the closest port to Asia. Most of the land is leased from 5 – 20 years. The Red Lion at the Quay has a lease until 2033. The port is structured with diverse commodities to accommodate the fluxes in the economy.

The port is also a Steward of Environment. They capture and treat all the storm water runoff, and have received an award for being environmental.

The rail bridge that crosses the Columbia River although old has never had any incidents and there are currently no plans to update it.

The city of Vancouver as well as the state has no jurisdiction over what the port transports. Todd finished up with Pros and Cons to the oil terminal and Q&A.
